The Continuing Membership Education Program (CMEP) is a program dedicated to developing and educating Sisters in categories such as: professional development, knowledge of Tau Beta Sigma and its ideals, mental and physical health, as well as valuable life skills. This committee is designed to be the forerunners of the CMEPs across the district by providing lesson plans, workshops, and guidance for all SED chapters to have a successful CMEP committee of their own.

Last year, the CMEP committee was able to put together and release an SED CMEP Handbook giving a great foundation on what CMEP is, how to establish one in your chapter, and some successful goals and guidelines.

This year's CMEP will be about continuing to add to the handbook and making it an effective resource among chapters across the district. Committee members will brainstorm ideas for lesson plans and workshops to include in the book along with ideas to make the handbook as accessible and usable as possible. Also, this handbook provides sections for chapters to submit ideas even if they're not on the committee. Members of this CMEP committee will monitor any incoming submissions and work with the ideas received from across the district.
