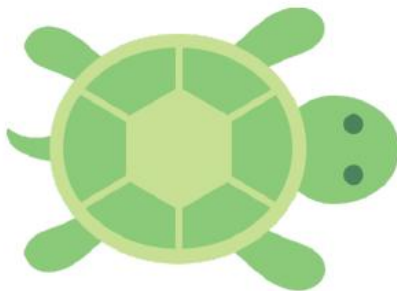

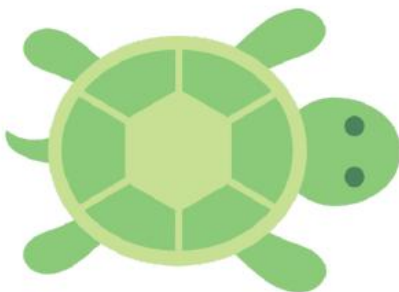
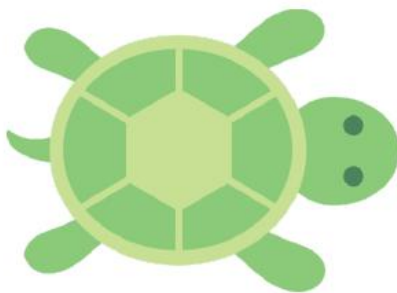

Katelyn Waldron is currently a senior at the University of South Florida majoring in

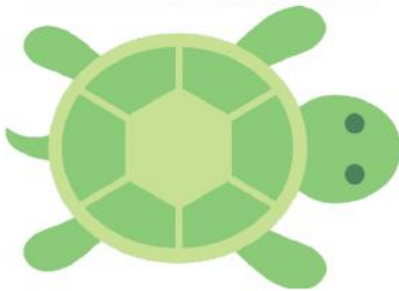
